They say "rust never sleeps", but sometimes it seems that, not content with just staying awake, it likes to put in a lot of overtime.

Checking over the Commando the other day, I spotted that the relatively new master cylinder cap had white deposits/stains on it. Giving it a rub with my fingers, I was a bit surprised to see bits of aluminium flaking off it. I replaced the last one when it fell to bits in my hand when removing it to check the level and that was only eighteen months ago.



What is really noticeable is that it is the knurled surface that is succumbing most quickly to the attack - the polished top surface is staining, but not rotting away. Is there a metallurgical reason for this, anyone? Has the crushing effect of the knurling weakened the material or is it simply that the knurled surface collects and holds salty water? Now that I think on it, the alloy seat knobs went exactly the same way. They were replaced with stainless ones of a nice pattern from RGM.

We are very aware of the damaging effect of the salt spread on the roads over the winter, and I wonder how long it stays "active". We have had

plenty of rain to wash it off, but maybe a more thorough Spring clean is needed. Or a plastic master cylinder cap (pity the later ones don't fit).
